<u> 1 Corinthians11 – The main and the plain</u>

1. Authority and subordination of authority is a critical foundational element of all God honoring worship in the church. Vss. 2-3

2. When the Corinthian men prophesied and prayed with their actual heads covered and when the Corinthian women prophesied and prayed with their actual heads uncovered it in some way brought shame to the metaphorical head or authority over them. Vss. 4-16

3. The Corinthian church had turned the Lord's Supper into a mockery and because of that they were experiencing God's discipline in significant ways. Vss. 17-34
